<b>Fees &amp; Cancellations</b>	£16.00 Senior and Junior <b>Cancelations</b> - we will not reimburse cancelation fees after the closing date for the competition.
<b>Awards</b>	<b>The awards are based on the scores of that day.</b> Medals will be allocated based on entries for each category. 1-3 entries 1 <sup>st</sup> place medal, 2-5 entries 2 <sup>nd</sup> place medal 6+ entries 3 <sup>rd</sup> place medal

<b>Target List</b>	A target list will be available on the Hillingdon's website as soon as reasonably possible after the closing date.

<b>Liability</b>	None of Hillingdon Archers or Judges, or affiliated parties can accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury however caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
<b>Photos</b>	Anyone wishing to use photographic/video equipment at a tournament must register prior to the start of the shoot. This includes mobile phone cameras.
<b>GDPR</b>	By entering Hillingdon's competitions, you agree that the information you provide may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, ArcheryGB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents relating to the event in the year of 2025. This information includes your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, e-mail address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. A target list will be published prior to the event, available on the Hillingdon's website. Results will be published as soon after the tournament as possible.
<b>AGB Rules</b>	By entering our competitions, you are agreeing to abide by AGB Rules of shooting and the regulations of these tournaments.  A Junior's parent/guardian must sign on behalf of the Junior, and in the case of a Junior under 16 yrs. must notify the Tournament Organiser of the senior person who will be taking due care and responsibility for that junior the whole time he/she is on Hillingdon's premises.
