Rounds/ Faces	All Archers will be shooting on Tenzone Layered Foam Bosses WA 70m round for recurve and longbow; shot on a 122cm full face WA 60m round for recurve and longbow; shot on a 122cm full face WA 50m round for all barebow; shot on a 122cm full face. WA 50m round for all compound; shot on individual 6 zone 80cm face Archers may choose which round they shoot, but only archers shooting in their WA assigned category/distance may claim records. No single round entries Age Categories will be Open, Female, Junior Open and Junior Female (U18) There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details.
